Attention All Foreign Exhibitors!

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques in "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "at Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase bankdrafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Thanks.
